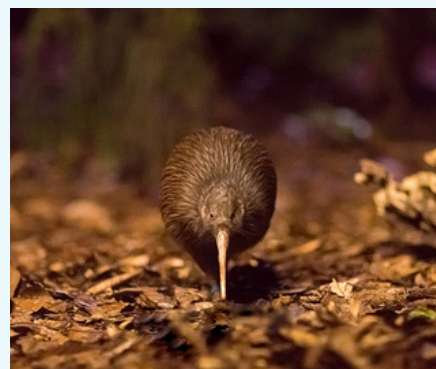

## OUR NEW ZEALAND STORY

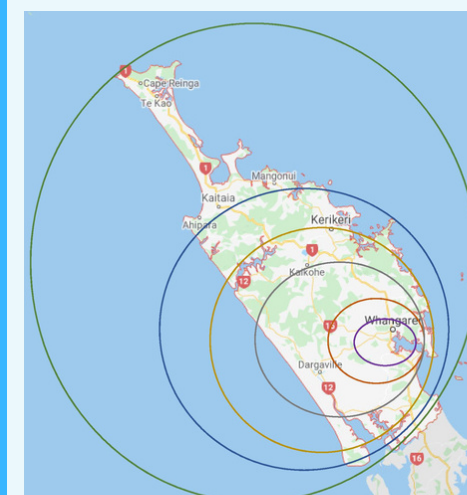
Our **Whangarei Museum, Whare Taonga** holds the largest insect collection in the Southern hemisphere, examples of developing technologies, kōrero from the Northern wars, natural history, and ngā taonga Māori o te rohe—local Māori artefacts. Long term and temporary exhibitions.

Northland's only nocturnal **Kiwi House** advocating for our native taonga species: kiwi, tuatara and gecko - moko

**Heritage Park** has a collection of historic buildings demonstrating Northland's early colonial history between the late 1850s to the early 1900s. Our focus is on your experience with our stories.

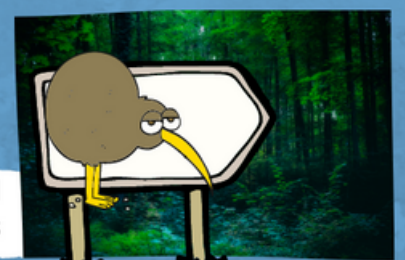

How many students can visit Kiwi North?

50 - 60 students from one school on-site at a time is the optimum group size for a visit

What is the typical duration of a visit?

Most groups spend between 2 - 4 hours with us.
